***Lenten Discovery:  
“The Arts in Worship”***

What are you giving up for Lent? How about giving up your Wednesday evening? This year we are offering intergenerational activities on Wednesday evenings during Lent. We'll share supper at 5:30, split into three activity groups from 6:30 to 7:30, and join together for closing worship from 7:30 to 7:45. Childcare and children's worship activities will be available for all Lenten activities. Plan to join us 2/24, 3/3, 3/10, and 3/17.

***Children's Lenten Banners***

Children and adult crafters join together to study names and symbols for Jesus as they create 4 worship banners. Children will also rehearse the procession and dedication script for presenting the banners in Sunday worship.

***Intergenerational Handbell Choir***

Adults and 6th to 12th graders will rehearse handbell numbers for use in worship.

***Living the Last Supper***

Interested adults and teens will rehearse for this Maundy Thursday (April 1st) pairing of drama and art. There are five speaking parts in this script.

***Palm / Passions Sunday, March 28***

On this day we remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, which we mark with the waving of palms and singing of Hosanna. We acknowledge the somberness of His passion, the beginning of Holy Week.

The congregation gathers in the Atrium for procession into the sanctuary. The anthem is a musical setting of Psalm 118, "Open the Gates," accompanied by handbells.
