



Sunday, March 12th 2023
3rd Sunday in Lent

This Sunday we talked about the expression “March goes in like a lion, out like a lamb” and what it means to be a “lamb of God.” We learned and sang the chorus to the hymn Lamb of God, printed here:

Oh Lamb of God, Sweet lamb of God
I love the Holy Lamb of God
Oh wash me in His precious Blood
My Jesus Christ the Lamb of God

There are longer versions of the song available if you want to learn the verses, and sheet music shouldn't be difficult to find.

Our craft this week used a paper plate, crayons, cotton balls, and black construction paper. We cut around the edge of the paper plate to make a mane for the lion, and decorated the face in the center (you can get creative here and use buttons, string, whatever you want to decorate the lion). On the back, or on another paper plate, we fluffed up and glued cotton balls down to be the wool of the lamb. Then we used black construction paper to make a face and ears for the lamb, with googly eyes, or more layered construction paper.
